FII RESOURCES

Families who partner with FII get access to our Resource Hub—a pool of funds and other opportunities families can use to fuel their initiative. Resources* are developed based on what we learn from families and may include:

- Laptop or technology stipend to complete online journals
- Compensation for time invested and data provided
- Matched Savings
- Loans
- Scholarships
- UpTogether community building site
- Fellowships

**Eligibility for each resource varies*

FAMILY OUTCOMES

On average, during two years of engagement with FII, families report:

▲ 20% INCREASE
in monthly income
with a
▼ 62% DECREASE
in subsidies such as
TANF and SNAP

Families increase their monthly savings account balance from less than \$100 to over \$1,000 and their total liquid assets from less than \$100 to over \$2,000.

FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Attend monthly meetings with your group—share goals and experiences, knowledge and resources, and set your own agenda—this is your time!

- Submit online monthly journal
- Facilitate cohort meetings; notes and sign-in sheet
- Meet for quarterly audit with staff as requested

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

GET A REFERRAL

- Learn about FII from a current family member. To learn more, have them refer you to staff. (Exceptions may apply.)

CREATE A COHORT

- Organize friends, colleagues, and community members into a group of 5 or more families with whom you want to work with every month.
- Groups can not be composed primarily of your immediate family members.

TELL US ABOUT YOURSELF

- Families complete a nomination form requesting info on household income, children's ages, and personal aspirations and goals.

CONVENE WITH YOUR GROUP AND LEARN ABOUT FII

- Meet with your group members, FII, and referring family for at least two pre-enrollment informational meetings. (All group members must be present.)

ENROLL AND PARTICIPATE

- Complete online enrollment profile and create first journal with staff.
- Begin monthly group meetings, journal submissions, and audits with staff.

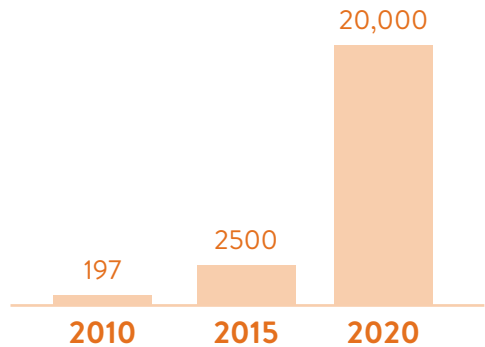
